





What % of Mothers in TN are Family Breadwinners?

Women Don't Earn Enough to be Economically Secure (Statewide)

126,887 single-mother families have an annual income below \$40,000.

36,356


single mothers in East TN have an annual income below \$50,000.

\$20,496 -\$30,769




Women of Color are Less Economically Secure

Communities of color make up a disproportionate share of Covid-19 cases



Crisis is hitting Nashville's Hispanic community particularly hard



Tennessee's unemployment rate shot up in April, remains elevated


